Yearly Aggregate Club Aggregates & Matches Class System:

1. All unclassified shooters will start in class A for a minimum of 3 monthly aggregates to establish class.
2. Classifications will be continually tracked, unless they have not competed for a period of 5 years and at that time they will be reclassified as unclassified, unless they receive a club vote for exception as requested.
3. Two consecutive monthly totals out of class will reclassify the competitor into their new class.
4. Junior Class (Page 1) – Age as of the first club shoot in March each year sets their class for the year.
5. Rifle - Offhand matches classes:
 - a. A Class (200 – 150 Points total out of 200 per 4 match target aggregate)
 - b. B Class (149 – 90 Points total out of 200 per 4 match target aggregate)
 - c. C Class (89 and below points total out of 200 per 4 match target aggregate)
6. Pistol match classes: (Club Pistol & Revolver may be shot one or two hand hold, competitors' choice)
 - a. A Class (200 – 150 Points total out of 200 per 2 match target aggregate)
 - b. B Class (149 and below points total out of 200 per 2 match target aggregate)

Yearly Aggregate Club Aggregates & Matches Awards:

1. Awards are calculated by the total best 4 out of 5 monthly match point totals for each aggregate & class.
2. Match expenses are subtracted for fees collected.
3. Remaining fees are split 50/50 Shooter Awards and club operating expenses and overhead.
4. Award certificates will be printed and presented along with the cash prizes at the December Planning Meeting.

Additional Rules:

- ✳ All Club matches, unless stated otherwise, may be shot with AMS (Any Metallic Sights)
- ✳ All Targets must remain stapled to the cardboard and turned in to the scoring shed after the relay
- ✳ Please place all target stickers in the bottom right corner of your target.
- ✳ Do not cover target staples with your sticker or staple though your sticker
- ✳ Program subject to change pending rule changes and target availability
- ✳ Black Powder & Black Powder Substitute Only. Rifle & Pistol Patch Lead Round Ball Only.
- ✳ Any NMLRA Legal Revolver - Muzzle-loading and Cap & Ball firearms with Ball or Lead Bullet.
- ✳ Exception Air guns compliant with the club rules.
- ✳ Failure to comply with this rule will result in suspension and removal from the range.
- ✳ Some Special 4-Day Matches as Noted may allow for other than Patched Round Ball.
- ✳ No Shooting Jackets (NMLRA Non-Jacketed Only)
- ✳ Supportive Back Braces are OK as needed
- ✳ Please refer to the Ft Osage Constitution & By-Laws for all Range and Match Rules.

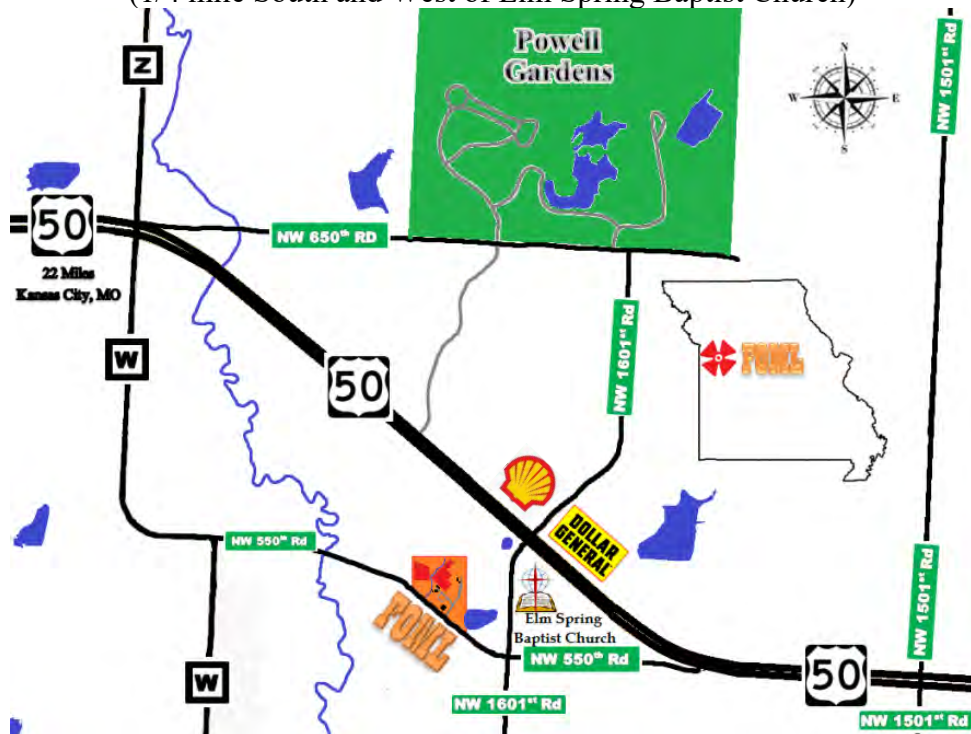

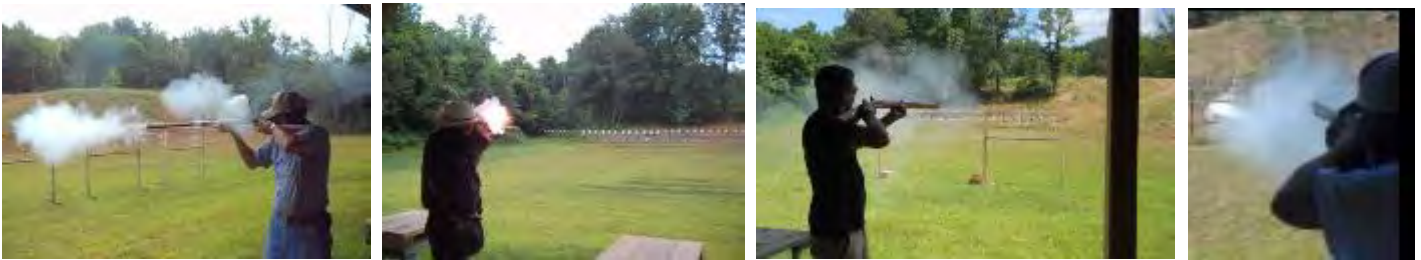


Shooters, Public & Traders Welcome at all FOML Posted Events!
